Assessment of potential for further research and archaeological investigation

High: There is high potential for further documentary research on the development of orchards and the orchard industry (esp cider and perry making) in this area, aided by the considerable quantity of documents and maps relating to this parish which are held at the HRO and Hereford Cathedral Archives. A sizeable quantity of information relating to orchards and cider/perry making was also gleaned from local newspapers dating back to the early 19th century.

Hereford Museum holds two particularly important collections of topographical views of Breinton and its environs by James Wathen and Brian Hatton. There is particularly high potential for further archaeological investigation of the medieval manorial enclosure site to the SW of the church (Breinton Camp) which was investigated in 1922 and again in 1959-62 and the earthworks of a possible deserted medieval settlement to the NW, both of which are located within known orchard sites.
